Electrolux 2Q Major Appl. N.A. Sales Down 2%

Electrolux Major Appliances North America sales were down 2.3% to \$1.35 billion for the second quarter ended June 30. Currency had a negative 0.8% effect. Organic sales were down 1.5%. Sales of core appliances were down, reflecting declines in private label products. Sales of own brands were up, and sales of air conditioners and dehumidifiers were up significantly.

Total Electrolux Group sales were down 4.4% to 29.98 billion Swedish krona. Acquisitions contributed 0.1%, while organic growth was down 0.9%. Currency exchange had a 3.6% negative impact. Net income was up 77% to SEK 1.08 billion; gross profit was 21.2% of sales, up from 18.7%.

In January, Alan Shaw joined the company as head of Major Appliances North America. Shaw succeeded Jack Truong, who left in April 2015 after four years in the role. Shaw reports to Jonas Samuelson, pres./ceo of Electrolux Group since February. Samuelson succeeded Keith McLoughlin, who left two months after the company's agreement to buy the GE Appliances business for \$3.3 billion fell through.
